Leadership Letter

Last spring, we asked a variety of Arizonans to describe the American Red Cross. Overwhelmingly, we heard the same response – “help.” We heard comments like, “The Red Cross is people *helping* people, no matter what the situation is,” and “The Red Cross is a *helping* hand.”

Arizonans also told us how important Red Cross disaster response is to their community. When we asked why, they said, “If the Red Cross doesn’t do it, who will?”

Fortunately, more than 3,000 Arizonans didn’t have to ask, “who will?” last year when their lives were shattered by disaster. Our American Red Cross Grand Canyon Chapter was at their sides, helping them through those critical first hours and days after tragedy struck.

More than 1,300 of our Gulf Coast neighbors didn’t have to ask, “who will?” when they fled to Arizona to escape hurricanes Katrina, Rita and Wilma. More than 600 found comfort and safety at the Operation Good Neighbor shelter managed by the Grand Canyon Chapter in partnership with the State of Arizona. For 21 days, more than a thousand local Red Cross volunteers cared for these Gulf Coast evacuees.

Certainly, the Red Cross national hurricane response faced challenges. In total, more than 4 million Gulf Coast residents received Red Cross assistance and the recovery phase continues. At times, resources were stretched and systems were strained. With these challenges came lessons in how to better prepare, operate and partner. Organizationally, we continue to improve.

Your American Red Cross is where Arizonans come together to help each other, and often, to help others beyond our state borders. During the hurricanes of 2005, Arizonans donated more than \$21 million. To help meet the escalated need for services, close to 200 Arizonans volunteered as part of the Red Cross “Give Hope Now” initiative.

Disaster isn’t the only time people of our state stepped forward to help. A growing number were trained in lifesaving skills and are ready to make the difference at the moment of life or death. Our Red Cross instructors have been updated on new CPR techniques that can be used to save even more lives in our communities. Our local business partners have helped us take Water Whiz Kidz water safety messages into schools.

While the past year was defining, the Grand Canyon Chapter looks to the future. We are in the process of searching for a new CEO to lead this dynamic and fast-growing chapter. We explore new, compelling and innovative ways to bring people together to help one another. Whether by making a financial gift, volunteering time or being trained to save a life, by partnering with the American Red Cross you are sure to do something extraordinary to help someone in your community. As a result, no Arizonan will have to ask the question, “Who will?”

IN FISCAL YEAR 2006 THE GRAND CANYON CHAPTER...

Disaster Services

Every hour of every day, the American Red Cross is there to assist families devastated by disaster. This includes immediate provisions of shelter, food and clothing, as well as assistance in a long-term recovery plan. Our primary disaster response is to house and apartment fires. All Red Cross disaster assistance is free. During FY 06, we:

- Responded to 600 disaster incidents...that's 1 disaster every 15 hours.
- Served more than 5,558 meals and snacks.
- Assisted 3,082 victims with immediate disaster relief needs and shelter.
- Provided financial assistance to 1,000 families.

Armed Forces Emergency Services

The American Red Cross was born on the battlefield as Clara Barton worked to help Civil War soldiers. The Red Cross continues that unique bond with our Armed Forces by providing round-the-clock emergency communications between military members and their families. Additionally, we provide assistance to military families in crisis, connecting them to vital resources for emotional and financial support. During FY 06, we:

- Linked an average of 5 families in crisis each day with loved ones in the military around the world.
- Provided \$46,359 in financial assistance to military families in emergency need.
- Handled 1,097 calls to provide information and referrals to partner agencies.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Responded to 1 disaster every 15 hours, not including the Chapter's response to Hurricane Katrina.
- Deployed 1,300 volunteers and employees to local and national assignments in response to Hurricane Katrina.
- Spent over \$944,000 to provide immediate disaster relief to victims of the Gulf Coast Hurricanes. This includes sheltering, feeding, emotional support and financial assistance to our new neighbors in Arizona.
- Provided immediate disaster needs and shelter to 11% more victims than the previous year.
- Provided financial assistance to 21% more families.
- Provided emergency hotel rooms to 84% more domestic violence victims when shelters were full.

International Services

The American Red Cross works with the International Red Cross and Red Crescent societies to link families separated by armed conflict, natural disaster, or civil unrest in their home countries. The American Red Cross language bank provides emergency translation for immigrants, refugees and international visitors in crisis. During FY 06, we:

- Reunited 9 Arizona families with their loved ones in other countries.
- Transmitted 35 International Red Cross messages.

Domestic Violence Services

The American Red Cross fills a vital need in the Valley's support of domestic violence victims – free, safe transportation to flee their abuser and a safe place to stay when area shelters are full. During FY 06, we:

- Provided 886 taxi rides to clients (women and children)...that's a taxi ride every 10 hours.
- Provided hotel/motel rooms to an average of 31 people each week when domestic violence shelters are full.
- Relocated 3 families through the use of 180,000 donated America West Airlines frequent flyer miles.

Preparedness & Safety Training & Education

Every day, lives in our community are saved because someone was trained in American Red Cross lifesaving skills. This training ranges from our CPR/First Aid certification, including classes in Spanish and for the hearing impaired, to training for youth who care for siblings or want jobs as babysitters. Additionally, we train the majority of lifeguards and water instructors in our 10-county chapter. During FY 06, we:

- Trained 75,563 people in CPR, First Aid, Aquatics, Water Safety, and other educational classes...that's more than 207 people every day.
- Trained 31,150 people in life-guarding, learn-to-swim, and water safety classes.

Volunteers are the lifeblood of our organization. Every service we provide is dependent upon their selfless dedication.

During FY 06:

- Volunteers gave more than 105,000 hours...potentially saving the Chapter almost \$2 million in salary and benefits.
- 1,660 new volunteers were trained.

The Grand Canyon Chapter of the American Red Cross is where people in Arizona come together to help each other every day. We are a network of neighbors who are there at the most critical of times, to help during a disaster, to save a life by giving CPR, by donating blood or in countless other ways.

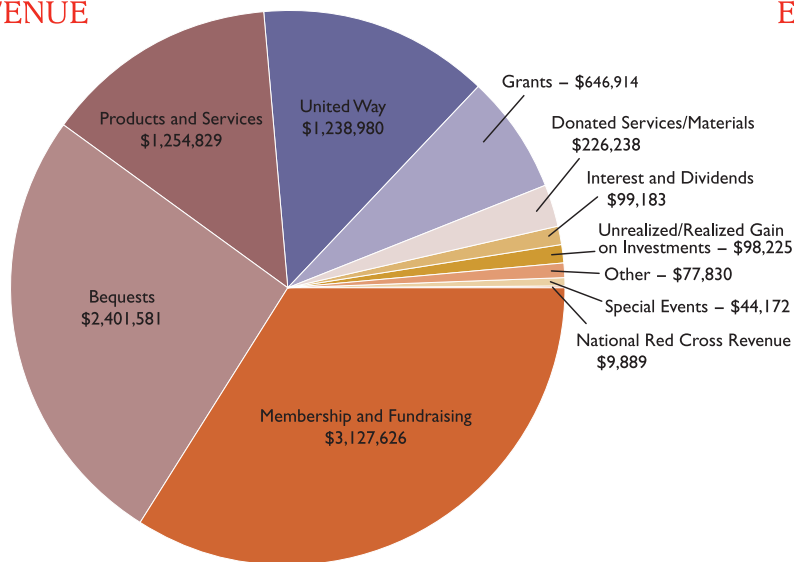

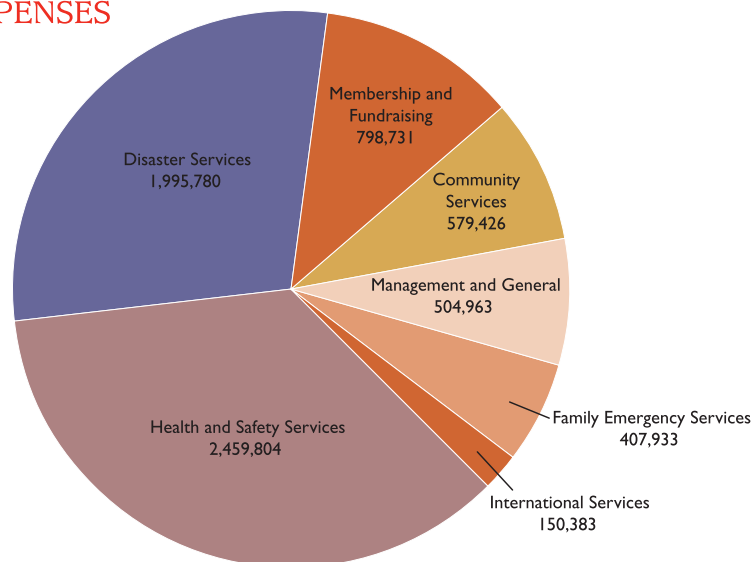
